Gates open for check-in at 4:30pm

- Parking is free and available on grass lawns inside Freeman Lake Park.
- Handicap parking is available on asphalt. However, note that the entire event is held in a field.
- With your full price ticket, you will receive eight (8) tasting tickets that can be redeemed at any wine tables. You can purchase additional tastings for \$1 each at the main gate check in table or at the Bourbon's Backyard/Beer table (located under the tasting tent).
- At the winery tables, you may purchase by the glass or by the bottle as well.
- If you purchase by the bottle, your wine will be "checked" and you'll be given a check card with your number so you do not have to walk around with your heavy bottle. Once you exit, pick up your bottles at the exit by showing your check card to the staff.
- No outside food or drink, no exceptions!
- Bring blankets and chairs, all seating will be festival style seating. Due to Covid there won't be seating available on-site provided.
- Age 10 and under are free; ages 11-20 are \$10 each; anyone not wanting to receive glass or tastings is \$10 (non-tasting ticket), or if you're a Designated Driver (DD) it's \$10 to get in. Otherwise, everyone over 21 is full price ticket.
- Do not over-consume. You will be cut off and escorted out to a taxi that you will be required to pay for.
- Most winery tables and food vendors take credit cards, but have cash on hand just in case.
- Dogs on leashes are permitted; you must clean up after them.
- No refunds, event will be held rain or shine-wear shoes that work within the weather!
- No re-admittance.
- Please adhere to the 6 ft. rule out of respect to everyone else. Wear a mask if mandated by the Governor or if you're comfortable doing so. Do not shame others that choose not to.
- Sanitize your hands when you get the chance to.
